

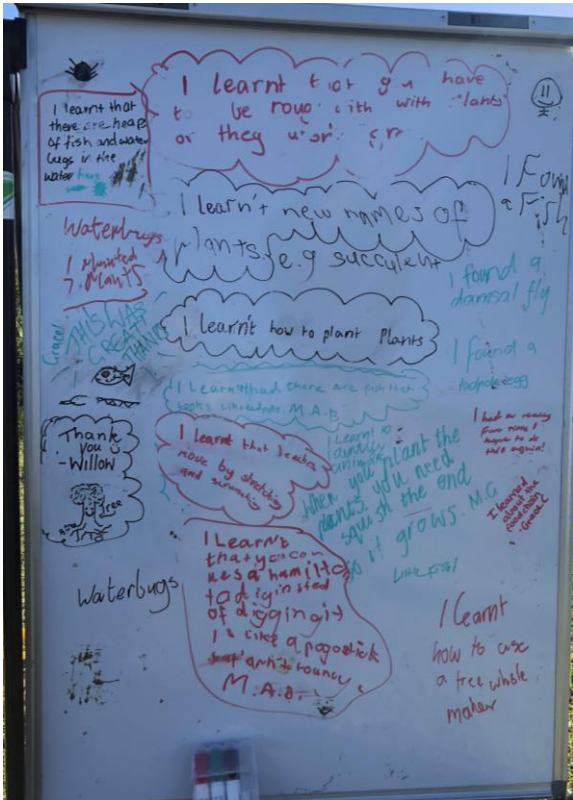
Star of the Sea Primary School
