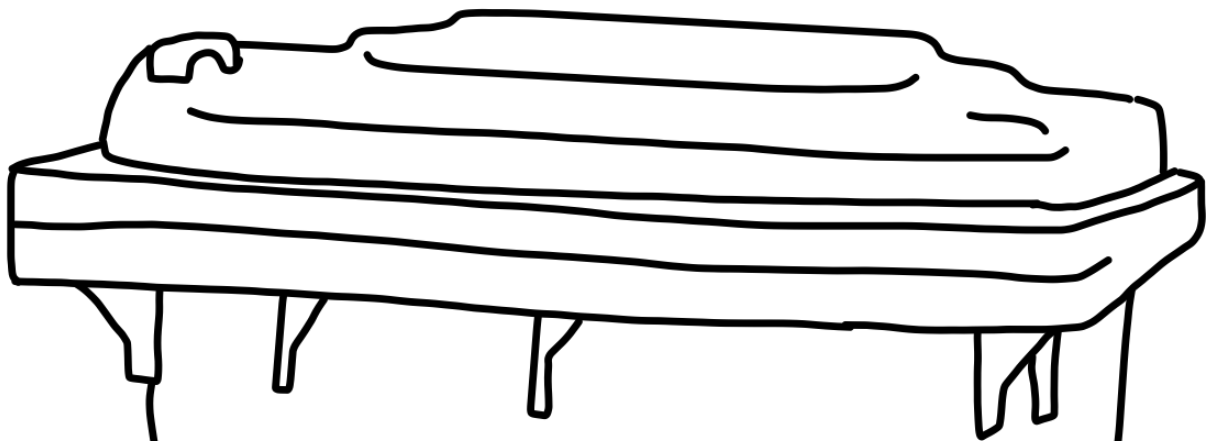


# rubbish bin

compostable'



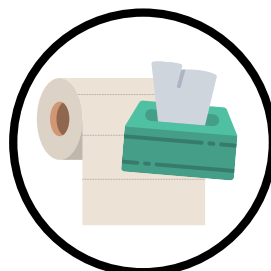
some light

recycling



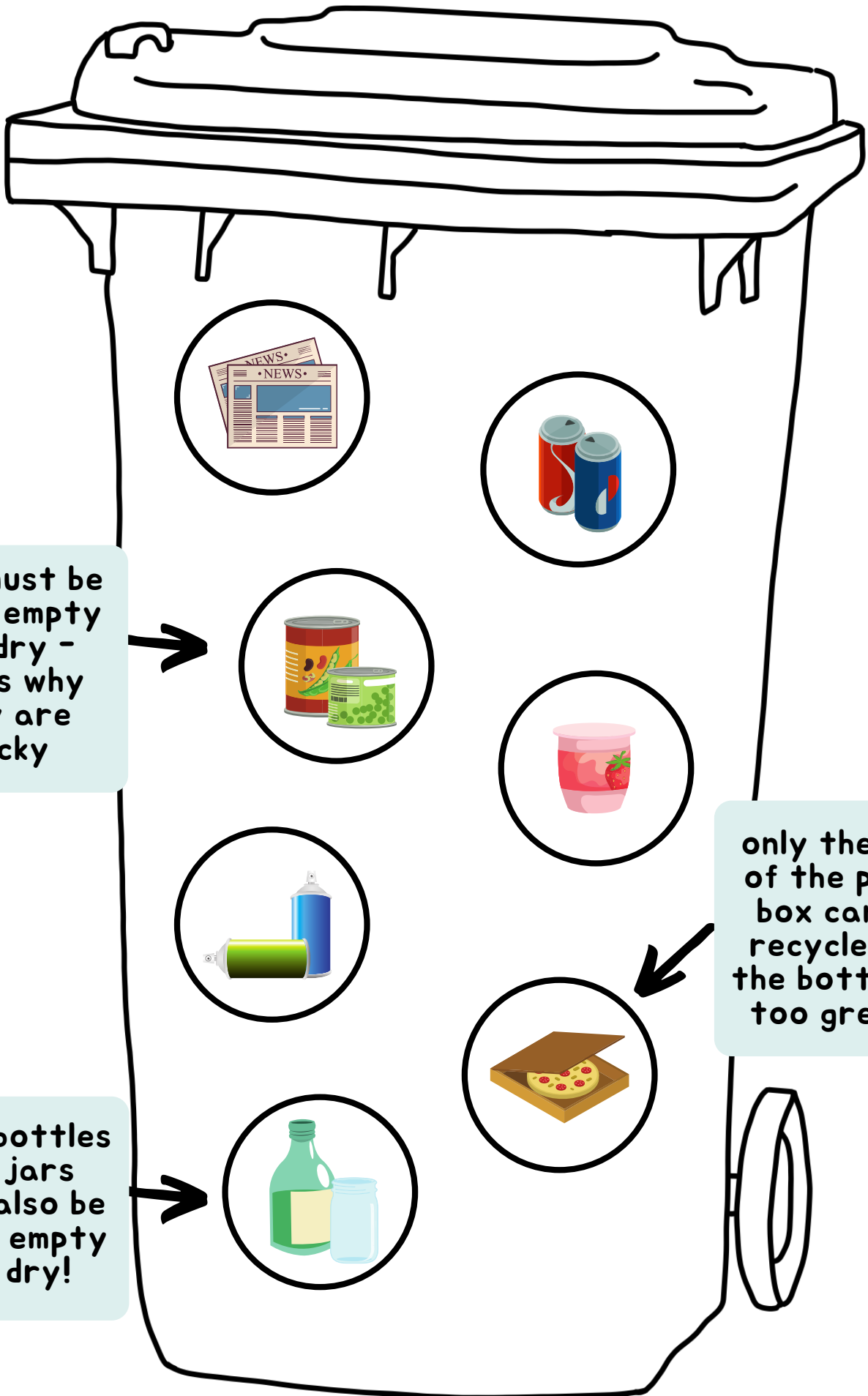
paper towel,

3. bottles

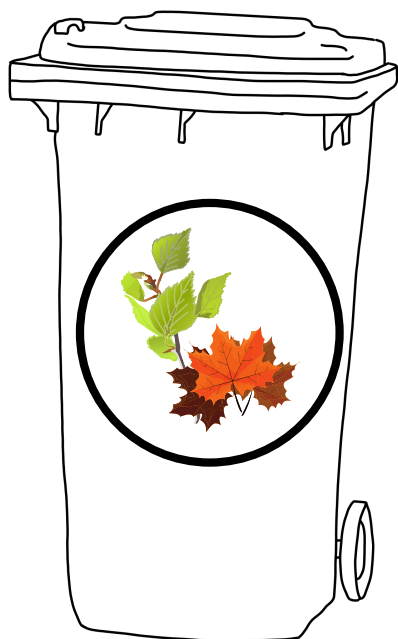


cans must be

tricky

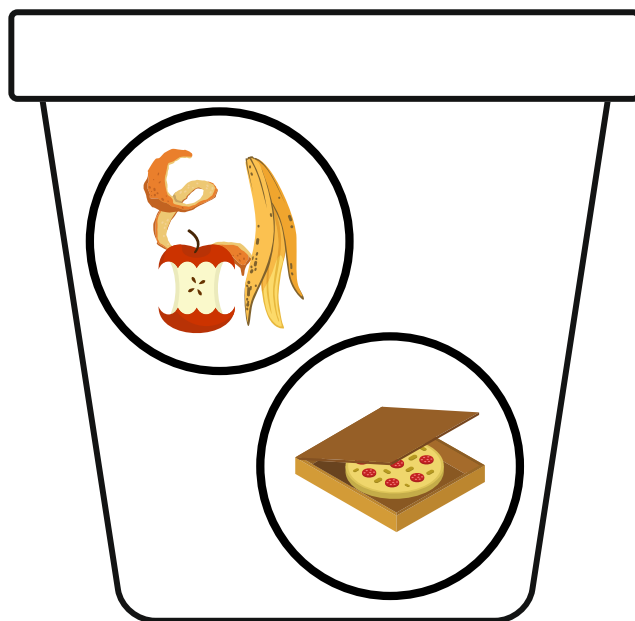
only the top

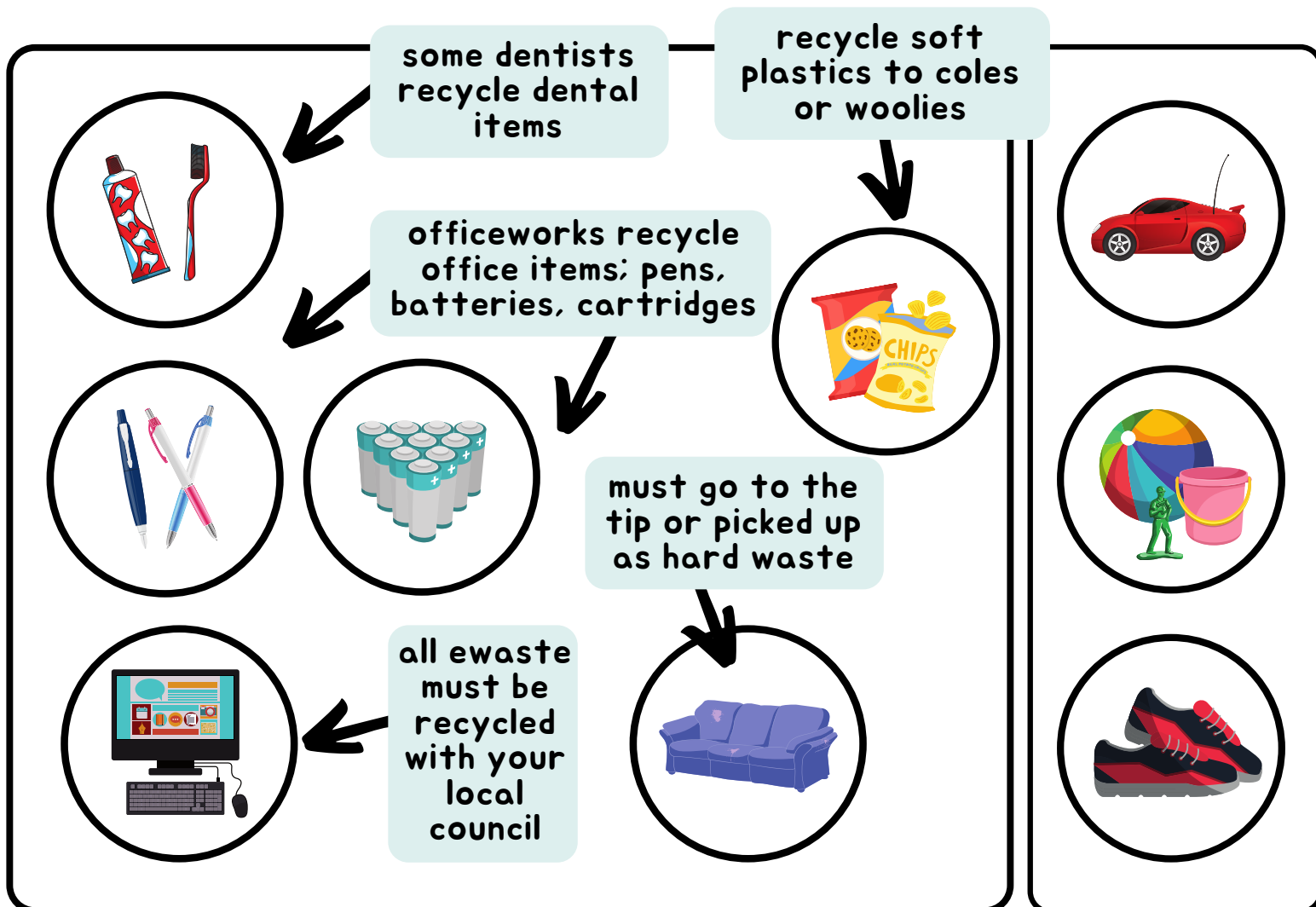

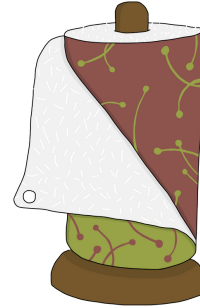


# Choose to reuse Answers

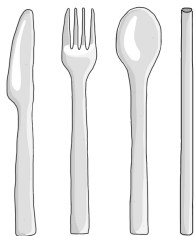

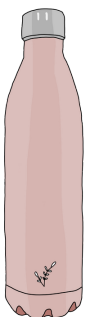

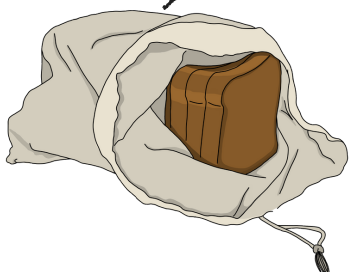
