

How Can I Help?

- ✓ Stay up to date with fishing regulations by downloading the Vic Fishing App
- ✓ Accidentally caught rays must be returned to the water immediately, unharmed
- ✓ You must not take any rays over 1.5m wide
- ✓ No ray species of any size can be caught within 400m of any pier, jetty, wharf or breakwater



Wadawurrung Cultural Heritage Fact

This species has the potential to cause injuries, so cultural knowledge of species was vital to keep safe. It was important to learn, listen and watch. Wadawurrung people only ate and cooked immediately whilst fresh.

Ramsar Species

This animal is one easily spotted gliding along the seagrass of Swan Bay, an internationally recognised Ramsar wetland. Swan Bay, Lake Connewarre and Mud Islands are all included in this wider Ramsar site.
