


Ramsar Wetlands

Saltmarsh ecosystems are found in places like Lake Connewarre and Swan Bay which are some of the wetlands that are included in the Port Phillip Bay (Western Shoreline) and Bellarine Peninsula Ramsar site. These wetlands have international importance under the 'Ramsar Convention on Wetlands' and is just one of 2000 across the globe. One of the main reasons to protect Ramsar wetlands is to protect migratory birds that visit them during our summmer.

- Prevent stock from grazing saltmarsh and remove levies
- Avoid walking or driving through saltmarsh
- Join a local conservation group to help with weeding
